TRIALS:

- Over sixty (60) trials currently in process
- Large variety of crops – leafy greens, row crops, perennials
- Focus on high margin crops
- Samples collected, including lab analysis showing trial results and confirming positive product attributes
- Second season confirmation of first season trial results
- State licensing and international licensing required to enable commencement of sales
- Sugar cane trials commencing with very large United States and Guatemalan Growers
- Customer orders received and shipped, order book expanding

MAJOR CUSTOMERS AND KEY ACCOUNTS:

- Several of the nations' largest agricultural distributors
- Several name brand growers for the United States, Mexico and Central and South America (creates a 12-month growing season)
- Company currently negotiating distribution and other strategic relationships
- Executed strategic collaboration agreements for use of BAM in biomass production as fuel feed stock
- Recent product introduction to the agricultural markets in Asia/Pacific Rim through a recently executed strategic marketing relationship

INTERNAL INFRASTRUCTURE:

- Focus on hiring and deploying field staff necessary to properly service the company's customers and distributors
- Internal I.T. Systems in place to control anticipated revenue and customer growth
- Staff necessary to administrate a fully reporting public company in place
- Production facility upgrade to allow for 34 million in possible sales over the next twelve (12) months
- Hired CEO/President and CFO
- Became a fully reporting public company
- Marketing collateral to support product sales in place and now being used in the field

SCIENCE OF BAM:

- Recently, new formulations of the BAM-Fx copper/zinc original product have been created and submitted to independent laboratory for testing. This testing confirmed that we were able to successfully introduce other elements into the basic formula. These new formulations have added other important elements which may ultimately lead to specific crop and soil formulations. The expansion of our science may form the basis of a broad and evolving product line for agriculture.

CONCLUSION:

- Based upon the foundation laid down in 2014 and the first half of 2015, the Company anticipates that the third and fourth quarter of 2015 will demonstrate an ever-increasing market acceptance of BAM-Fx. The Company expects to be able to introduce subsequent products into the BAM product line as we continue to develop field trial information on these potential new products.
